



Codes for plastic are found in the recycling triangle usually on the bottom of the bottle. #1 (PETE): soft drink, water, berry baskets and more. #2 (HDPE): milk, detergent, shampoo, oil bottles and more.

Please make sure your bottles are clean and lids are removed.
