

# E-Waste Recycling

Locally you can recycle electronics free of charge at the McKinley County Transfer Station on Hassler Valley Road in Gallup. You can recycle servers, monitors, keyboards, mice, printers, fax machines, phones, and small appliances (if you can plug it in you can recycle it). They are open Mon-Sat 8:00-5:00.
