America Recycles Day (ARD), celebrated annually on November 15, is the national day dedicated to encouraging Americans to RECYCLE and BUY RECYCLED products. The purpose of America Recycles Day is to promote the social, environmental, and economic benefits of recycling. The benefits of recycling (saves energy, water, landfill space, and \$) it is hoped would encourage more individuals and businesses to recycle, and municipalities to set up recycling programs.

Last year, 2,065 events were registered with 2.1 million people participating in America Recycles Day across the country.
