

Set Provide Regional SWA Transfer Station 863-5776 107 Hasler Valley Road **Open Mon - Sat. 7am—4:30pm** <u>Will accept</u> -aluminum, tin/steel cans, corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags, mixed paper, #1 & #2 plastics, all types of batteries, electronics that ran on batteries or have cords, solar (PV) panels if <u>they</u> <u>are working/reusable.</u> Old heavy, glass TVs are **NOT** recyclable. <u>Drop-Off fee</u> for large appliances (300 lbs or less) is \$7, more if heavier.




Accepting:

*Corrugated cardboard, brown paper *Plastic— All #1 and #2 clean plastics such as water, milk, & detergent bottles, berry & lettuce boxes. *Tin/steel cans (clean)

*Mixed paper—Junk mail, phone books, newspapers, magazines, catalogs, grayboard (cereal boxes, beverage can holders). No frozen food or aseptic cartons (juice box).
