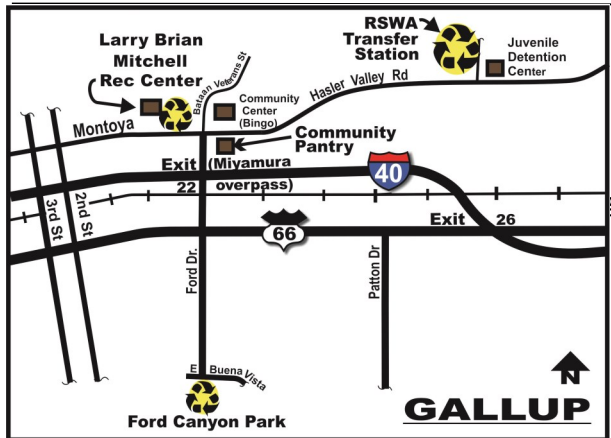

- *Aluminum



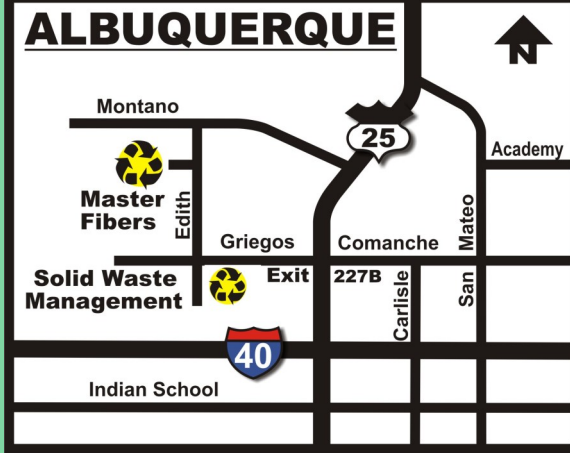

Will accept - corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags, plastics #1 & #2, all types of batteries, electronics that ran on batteries or have cords, solar (PV) panels if they are working/reusable. Old heavy, glass TVs are **NOT** recyclable. Drop-Off fee for large appliances (300 lbs or less) is \$7, more if heavier.

Mixed paper is not being accepted at the Community Bins or at the Transfer Station at this time. Please take to Albuquerque, Farmington or Flagstaff.
